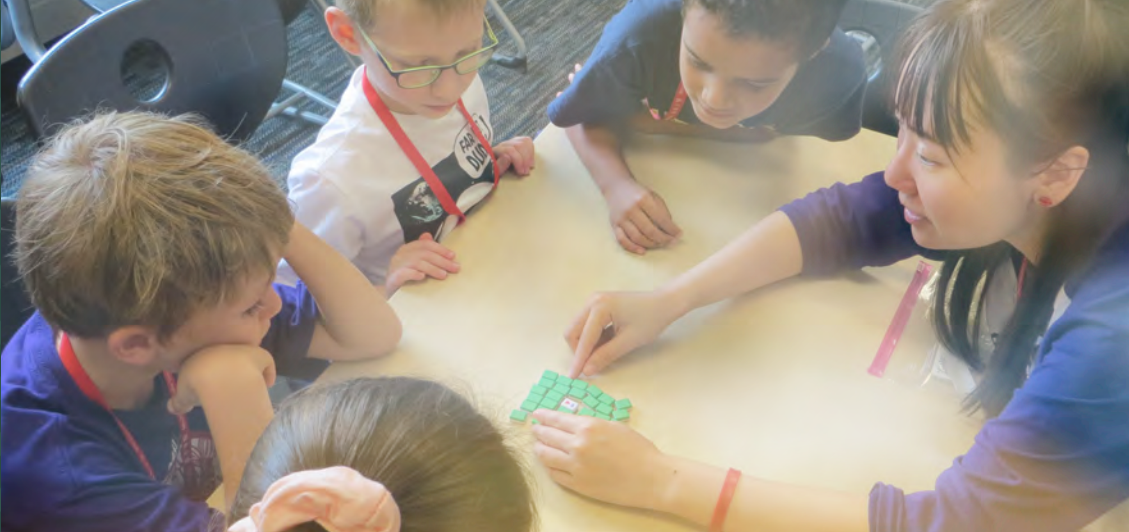

TWO PROGRAM OPTIONS

OPTION 1 TEACHER RESIDENCY

This full-time, two-year teacher preparation program will provide the knowledge, skills and support to develop into a highly effective teacher of Chinese and earn both **teacher certification and the Master of Arts in Teaching and Curriculum (MATC)**. Students receive fellowships of up to \$20,000. U.S. citizens/residents are also eligible to apply for the federal TEACH Grant.

APPRENTICESHIP YEAR: Internship in a K-12 school under the guidance of a mentor teacher and MSU field instructors, plus courses on campus one day a week

SUMMER: Coursework and pre-internship field experiences

RESIDENCY YEAR: Internship placement as the lead teacher in the initial school or another U.S. school district plus coursework

OPTION 2 TEACHER CERTIFICATION ONLY

This 1 year program leads to an initial (standard) Michigan secondary teaching certification with a K-12 Chinese endorsement.

INTERNSHIP YEAR: Internship in a K-12 school under the guidance of a mentor teacher and MSU field instructors, plus courses on campus one day a week

SUMMER : Coursework and pre-internship field experiences
