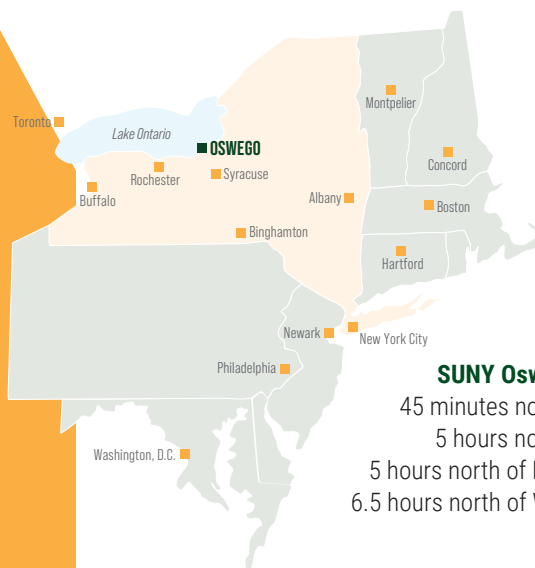

HOW TO APPLY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

STEP ONE

Apply online:

STEP TWO

Pay application fee

STEP THREE

Submit required documents, including:

- Official transcripts from all previously-attended institutions at the high school and university level (Minimum 2.5 GPA out of 4.0)
- English proficiency score (TOEFL: 71, IELTS: 6.0, Duolingo: 100)

STEP FOUR

Accepted undergraduate students must also provide proof of financial support and a copy of the passport biographic page.

Step THREE

Submit required documents, including:

- Sealed official college transcripts
- WES Evaluation
- English proficiency score (TOEFL: 79 for most programs, 83 for MBA; IELTS: 6.5, Duolingo: 105)

Step FOUR

Accepted students must also provide proof of financial support and a scanned copy of the biographic page of the passport.
